## INSTRUCTIONS

In case either or both the contracting parties, being single, or less than twenty years of age as regards the male and less than eighteen years as regards the female they shall exhibit to the Local Civil Registrar concerned the consent to their marriage of their father, mother, or guardian, or person having legal charge of them, in the order mentioned. Such consent shall be in writing, under oath taken with the appearance of the interested parties before the Local Civil Registrar concerned or in the form of a affidavit made in the presence of two witnesses and attested before any official authorized by the law to administer oaths. (Rep. Act 386, Art. 61).

For the purposes of the Marriage Law, by "guardian" is meant a guardian legality appointed by will or by a competent court for the person, or both the person and estate, of a minor. By "person having legal charge" is meant a person actually in lawful charge of a minor who has no father nor mother, legal guardian.
